<p>Outcome: Students will learn that Confirmation strengthens the baptismal conferral of the Holy Spirit on those Confirmed in order to incorporate them more firmly in Christ, strengthen their bond with the Church, associate them more closely with the Church’s mission, increase them in the gifts of the Holy Spirit, and help them bear witness to the Christian faith in words and deeds through service to prepare for the sacrament.</p>
