LET'S GO EXPLORE the world of Christian leadership together. In Kenosis Leadership, we seek to help you in the mission of making disciples, by equipping and empowering Christ-like leaders in our schools, parishes, and communities.

Our inspiration for the program comes from the model of leadership that Jesus Christ revealed in the Gospels, where leadership is not simply a skill learned but an exploration in the art of service-to-others.

The curriculum guides participants from conceptual leadership principles to concrete leadership skills. Participants explore each concept through outdoor adventures and team challenges. Together they develop real-life skills through team discussions and skill implementation.

In total, participants explore seven distinct concepts of leadership, each having multiple concrete and implementable skills.

SERVANT LEADERSHIP

Service is at the foundation of our curriculum because, through service, leaders have the greatest influence. Servant leaders elevate, equip, and empower those they serve, which brings about leadership multiplication. In this concept, participants will explore concrete methods of servant leadership.

W.W.H. LEADERSHIP

Discover the three questions that every leader must answer in order to lead with purpose and clarity. In this concept, participants will wrestle with their values and how to accomplish their strategic goals.

INSIDE OUT LEADERSHIP

What is the relationship between one's soul and one's ability as a leader? Leadership is more than simply learning a skill set. It requires a sense of transcendence and interior transformation. In this concept, participants will seek out their unique gifts as a leader.

D.B.L.D. LEADERSHIP

Great leaders are not made in a day. They are made in the little choices of every moment. Focusing on continued development and positive problem solving, participants will explore big dreams lived daily.

TINY - MIGHTY LEADERSHIP

It is a paradox that the most influential leaders became great by living lives of humble service. By their smallness, they overcome fears and failings that freeze so many leaders. In this concept, participants will explore the magnanimous leader.

R.E.S.P.E.C.T LEADERSHIP

Trust, character, integrity...how do we cultivate these as a leader? Understanding respect and how it is given and earned is essential for successful leaders. In this concept, participants will develop concrete methods of building respect.

VIRTUOUS LEADERSHIP

Joy is contagious and happiness attracts because we all desire fulfillment in our lives. Learning to live life virtuously, through the exploration of the cardinal virtues, gives us the tools necessary to live with joy and happiness. In this concept, participants will discover the implications of virtue in leadership.
