

## **St. Elizabeth Ann Seton and St. Anne Awards**

Two awards are specially designed for adult leaders who have been integral in the spiritual formation of Catholic Youth through the American Heritage Girls or Girl Scouting programs. These medals are archdiocesan recognition defined by and conferred by the Catholic Committee on Scouting (CCS) with the approval of the archbishop.

These awards recognize the excellent character of adults, their active leadership, and recognition by their Parish for their efforts to help youth develop their spiritual lives within the context of Catholic Scouting. The awards may be given to clergy, religious, non-Catholics, laymen or women.

**The St. Elizabeth Ann Seton Award** was inaugurated in 1980 to recognize adults with at least 2 years of success as an adult leader at the troop or parish level.

**The St. Anne Medal** is the highest national recognition for adults who serve Catholic youth through girls' organization. The recognition was inaugurated in 1957 and redesigned in 1980. This award is normally given to those with at least 7 years of successful leadership and service involving multiple troops or Parishes.




