
Our Commitment to You.



Medical professionals, the CDC, the American Camping Association and our camp staff are united in creating an adventurous, faith-filled camp environment in which we are committed to preventing the spread of COVID-19 at camp. This summer, we are going to operate under the additional guidelines outlined below. We have adventures planned that will build friendships and help continue our mission of connecting youth and families to Christ.



SOCIAL DISTANCING & MASKS

All campers and staff will be required to follow strict social distancing procedures where applicable. Campers and staff will not be required to wear masks most of the time, but during times where social distancing is not feasible, campers and staff will be required to wear one.



CLEANING PROTOCOLS

Staff will diligently clean common surfaces throughout the day and will be intentionally trained on all heightened cleaning protocols.



HAND SANITIZATION

All campers and staff will be highly encouraged to clean their hands constantly throughout the day by use of hand sanitizer or hand soap.



LIMITED TIME SPENT INDOORS

The majority of camp activities, including meals, will take place outdoors, limiting time both campers and staff will spend inside camp facilities. High school campers have the option of overnight camping at both High School MAX and Extreme. Each camper will be asked to bring a small tent. Campers will be able to share a tent with a sibling of the same gender or someone they have been quarantined with previous to camp. If campers decided to not sleep in a tent, they will be picked up at night and can return the next morning.



SCREENINGS

All staff and campers will partake in screenings including daily temperature checks.



SACRAMENTS

Mass and all faith formation activities will follow guidelines set forth by the Archdiocese of Kansas City in Kansas.



ACTIVITIES

Each activity is being evaluated to determine if it may need to be altered, enhanced, or swapped to protect the safety of all campers and staff.



RAPID RESPONSE

In the event that an illness, including COVID-19, presents, we will work closely with our medical advisors, notify families and take all necessary steps to isolate the spread and care for the health of the individual.



STAFF TRAINING

Our staff is receiving an intensified training regarding new COVID-19 protocols for the summer to ensure we are prepared to welcome campers and families in July.



BEFORE YOUR SESSION

We highly encourage all campers to adhere to strict social distancing protocols and increased handwashing prior to arriving at camp.
