Why do we need the "Value Them Both" Amendment?

The April 2019 KS Supreme Court *Hodes & Nauser vs. Schmidt* ruling:

- "discovered" a right to abortion in our 1859 Kansas Constitution.
- usurps the voice of Kansans on the abortion issue.
- puts at risk all of our existing and well-supported laws that protect women and save lives, such as -- a woman's right to know, safety standards, parental notification, and bans on late-term, partial-birth and tax-payer funded abortion.
- creates a nearly unlimited abortion industry in Kansas.
- enables the abortion industry to continue targeting minority communities and disproportionately affecting black lives.

The only recourse we have is to pass the "Value Them Both" Amendment. VTB does not ban abortions, but returns the ability of Kansans, through their elected representatives, to keep and pass reasonable regulations on the abortion industry that will protect women and save lives.

Where does VTB stand?

- This past January, the Kansas Legislature stood up to the abortion industry to support women and babies. They voted to put the Value Them Both amendment on the ballot next year.
- Now, Kansans will get the final say with a vote on the amendment in August of 2022.
