## STOP TAX-PAYER FUNDED ABORTION

**USCCB** Campaign

The Hyde Amendment has protected Americans from funding abortion for 45 years. It's credited with saving the lives of over 2.4 million children to date. Now, powerful members of Congress want to take away this law that both Democrats and Republicans have supported for nearly half a century. Without it, billions of taxpayer dollars could go to abortion. That means abortions would be cheaper, easier, and funded with our taxpayer dollars.

It is critically important for Catholics to send a strong message before Congress moves forward to impose taxpayer-funded abortion. Because of the incredibly high stakes Congress needs to hear from a massive number of people. Please help all in your parish to join our diocesan response to this nationwide effort by the USCCB, set for the first week of June. The primary goal is for millions of Catholics to sign the petition on NoTaxpayerAbortion.com.

The campaign to pass the Value Them Both state constitutional amendment for life is coming to life. This amendment is necessary after a KS Supreme Court ruling found and declared a state constitutional right to abortion in Kansas, placing in grave danger nearly every Kansas prolife law. Without the amendment, an unlimited and unregulated abortion industry, with taxpayer-funded abortion, late-term abortion and other hurtful practices, will almost certainly become a reality. It will be voted on in August of 2022, but there is much to do before then.

Every Catholic parish in Kansas is being called to engage this campaign as we seek to protect limits on the abortion industry in Kansas. We will be working with the Kansas Catholic Conference and our Knights of Columbus. The KCC has already met with KofC leaders to roll out a plan over the next few months. Please see the attached timeline and set up a time to meet with your parish Knights leaders to build a plan to work together

The key messaging of the campaign is:

- We Value Both Women and Babies.
- Unlimited abortion hurts Women and Babies.
- Value Them Both Amendment protects limits on the abortion industry.

We hope every parish will consider hosting at least one informational night about the Value Them Both amendment. There will be an array of other materials coming soon from the KCC, including a "church packet" with prayers, volunteer cards, flyers, bulletin announcements and inserts, bumper stickers and an order form for posters, yard signs and large display signs. There will also be a voter registration drive, an advance ballot drive and other events and activities. Archbishop Salvatore Cordileone of San Francisco has written a new Pastoral Letter titled "Before I Formed You in the Womb I Knew You". It is a Pastoral Letter on the "Human Dignity of the Unborn, Holy Communion, and Catholics in Public Life." If you have not already read it, it is an important read for all of us and for every Catholic as there is much confusion about abortion and about protecting the integrity of the Eucharist.
