### DAY 1: MONDAY, JUNE 5 DEPARTURE

Our pilgrimage begins today! We will depart from Kansas City and make our way to the Holy Land!

### DAY 2: TUESDAY, JUNE 6 ARRIVAL & TIBERIAS

Arrive in Tel Aviv and make our way to Tiberias. Upon arrival, we will check into the hotel, share a welcome dinner with wine, and stay overnight for two nights.

## DAY 3: WEDNESDAY, JUNE 7 MT OF BEATITUDES, TABGHA, CAPERNAUM & SEA OF GALILEE

We retrace the steps of Jesus to the sites where he taught and performed miracles. We begin our journey at the Mount of Beatitudes, the location of Sermon on the Mount. Next, Tabgha, the site where the miracle of the multiplication of fish and bread took place and to the Church of Peter's Primacy, the location of the miraculous catch. We enjoy a traditional St. Peter's fish lunch and continue to Capernaum where Jesus lived and started his ministry. Mass will be celebrated on the boat as we sail on the Sea of Galilee. Dinner will be at a local restaurant.

## DAY 4: THURSDAY, JUNE 8 MT. TABOR, CANA, NAZARETH & BETHLEHEM

We start our day by going to the heights of Mount Tabor, where the Transfiguration of Jesus took place. Mass will be celebrated at Cana, the site of Jesus' first miracle. Here couples may renew their wedding vows. We then go to Nazareth where we visit The Basilica of the Annunciation, St. Joseph's Church, Mary's Well, and the old market. Enjoy a relaxing bus ride to Bethlehem, where we will spend the next 5 nights.

## DAY 5: FRIDAY, JUNE 9 BETHLEHEM: SHEPHERD'S FIELD, CHURCH OF NATIVITY & EIN KAREM

In Bethlehem, we will visit the Shepherd's Fields and visit the Church of the Nativity that stands upon the site where Jesus was born. We have time for shopping in a local Christian cooperative store and visit a local Christian orphanage. Then, we visit Ein Karem, the birthplace of St. John the Baptist, and celebrate Mass at the Church of the Visitation, where the Virgin Mary visited her cousin, Elizabeth, and proclaimed the 'Magnificat.' Tonight, we will enjoy dinner at a local restaurant.

## DAY 6° SATURDAY, JUNE 10 JERUSALEM: MT OF OLIVES, PATER NOSTER, DOMINUS FLEVIT, GETHSEMANE & MT ZION

We begin our 'Jerusalem Experience' at the Mount of Olives starting with Pater Noster, where Jesus taught the Lord's Prayer to his disciples. We walk the Palm Sunday route stopping at Dominus Flevit, where Jesus wept over Jerusalem and where Mass will be celebrated. We continue our descent to the Garden of Gethsemane to pray at the Rock of Agony where Jesus prayed his last prayer before his arrest. Then, we step into the kitchen of Chef Nabil, to learn how to make the Holy Land's most famous dishes, falafel, and hummus (recipes included). We conclude our day on Mt. Zion with a visit to the Upper Room and St. Peter in Gallicantu, where Peter denied our Lord thrice (Psalm 88). We return to Bethlehem for dinner at our hotel.

## DAY 7: SUNDAY, JUNE 11 JERUSALEM: VIA DOLOROSA, CHURCH OF RESURRECTION, ST. ANNE'S & WAILING WALL

Today, we retrace the last steps of Jesus, as we pray the Stations of the Cross along the Via Dolorosa (Way of Sorrow). We reflect on the greatness of his sacrifice as we make our way to Calvary and the Tomb of Jesus Christ to celebrate Mass at the Church of the Resurrection (Holy Sepulcher), the holiest place for Christians. We visit St. Anne's Church, the birthplace of the Virgin Mary. Then on to the Wailing Wall, the holiest place for the Jews. The rest of the afternoon is open for visits to other holy sites, shopping, or resting at your hotel. Dinner is at leisure tonight to explore one of the many excellent restaurants.

## DAY 8: MONDAY, JUNE 12 VALLEY OF THE SHADOW OF DEATH, JORDAN RIVER, JERICHO & DEAD SEA

On our way to the Jordan River to renew our baptismal promises, we will stop at the Valley of the Shadow of Death. We visit the oasis town of Jericho where we will celebrate Mass. We see the Mt. of Temptation where Jesus fasted and was tempted by Satan. Enjoy a swim (or rather a float!) in the mineral-rich waters of the Dead Sea, renowned for its healing properties. We will return to Bethlehem for our Farewell Dinner with wine at a local restaurant.

### DAY 9: TUESDAY, JUNE 13 RETURN HOME

We pray that you've had a wonderful pilgrimage! Today we will be departing Israel and returning home!
