Entrances accessible in all church buildings (accessibly compliant ramps, automatic door openers, accessibly compliant doors)				
Wheelchair accessible pews (pew cutouts)				
Elevators that are accessibly compliant and regularly maintained				
Good, clear lighting				
Braille for church buildings, rooms, Mass materials, RE and faith formation materials				
Large-print bulletins and hymnals				
Accessibly compliant Ramps to the altars for Servers, Readers and EOMs with physical limitations				
accessibly compliant bathrooms				
Accommodations for liturgies, meetings, events are provided upon request (e.g., sign language interpreters, FM loops, large-print materials, Braille, et cetera)*				
Media Accommodations				
Available accommodations are indicated on all print, digital, and social media promotions				
Social Accommodations				
Provides opportunities to engage people with different communication abilities in total parish life				
Provides accessible opportunities for all persons of different abilities to engage in parish life (including faith learning opportunities that the parish provides)				
Communication Accommodations				
Provide captioning for videos (www.rev.com)				
If no captioning is available, make sure there is a transcript and/or ASL interpretation				

Learning Accommodations				
Adaptive curriculums for religious ed, Sacramental preparation, and school classes				
Provide accommodations for deaf and hard of hearing students				
Other Accommodations				
Separate, quiet room beside the cry room for individuals with sensory needs (includes sensory items for feeling, smelling, and hearing)				
Offer support groups for caregivers of individuals with special needs				
Offer respite care for caregivers of individuals with special needs				
Offer support groups for people with a mental illness diagnosis
