Frequently Asked Questions

Who may earn these activity patches?

Any Catholic youth, age six or older, or adult Catholic may earn the main central patch and any of the auxiliary award patches.

Is this activity considered a Religious Emblem and may a Scout receive a religious knot after completing this activity?

No. Since this activity is open to all Catholics, it is not considered an official Scout Religious Emblem. Scouts may not receive a religious knot for earning any of the activity patches.

Will there be more Eucharistic Revival activity patches?

These are limited-edition patches – only available through 2025 – and no additional patches as a part of this activity are planned.

Who may serve as a mentor for youth participants?

For younger youth, parental or guardian guidance is needed. For older youth and adults, self-verification only is needed.

Does an applicant need to submit proof of completion of requirements?

No. By submitting an order form and patch fee, the applicant self-certifies completion of the requirements. Younger youth may need parental or guardian assistance.

Does the main central patch requirement need to be completed before any of the auxiliary patches are awarded?

Yes. However, the auxiliary patch requirements can and should be worked on simultaneously with the central patch requirement. Once the central patch is earned, the other activity patches may be displayed around the central patch.

May auxiliary award patches continue to be earned after the central patch is earned?

Yes, until the conclusion of the Eucharistic Revival program.

If a participant cannot receive communion but fulfills the Mass attendance requirement, does that person qualify for the central patch?

Yes.

Eucharistic Revival Activity Program – through 2025

In conjunction with the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops the National Catholic Committee on Scouting is offering the Eucharistic Revival Activity Program. By offering this program the NCCS is lending support to the National Eucharistic Revival.

Requirements for the Eucharistic Revival Activity Program

The activities below are designed to encourage all to learn more about the True Presence of Christ in the Eucharist. Participants are required to complete the main central patch requirement first before any auxiliary activity patches may be displayed. All eight auxiliary activity patches may be earned and any five may be placed around the central patch.

Requirement for Main Central Patch: Attend Mass



Attend Mass (all participants) and receive the Eucharist (if made First Communion and have no moral impediment) for 12 weeks, preferably consecutively.

Activity 1



Receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation (or study the Ten Commandments if not made first penance).

Activity 2



Pray one Rosary of each of the Joyful, Luminous, Sorrowful and Glorious Mysteries.

Activity 3



Participate in family prayer (at least weekly) for 12 weeks.

Activity 4



Be active in ministry in your parish, such as altar server, choir member, lector, Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion, or usher (as age appropriate).

Activity 5



Attend Eucharistic Adoration (preferably with family).

Activity 6



Learn about and discuss five Eucharistic Miracles.

Activity 7



Participate in a Eucharistic Procession.

Activity 8



For younger youth, attend a Catholic activity, such as a diocesan Cub Scout event, where the theme is the Eucharist. For older youth and adults, attend a Catholic retreat where the theme is the Eucharist.
