1. Show pro-life movies: Unplanned, Bella, others! The Pro-Life Office has many on DVD.

2. Discuss ways to share positive messaging on Adoption – the Loving Option in our culture. Watch and share the Movie – "I Lived on Parker Avenue" (www.ilivedonparkerave.com).

3. Help Junior High age kids in Catholic schools start a Pro-Life Club.

4. Help a public school start a Pro-Life Club.

5. Host an educational event about the Kansas Constitutional Value Them Both Amendment for your school community (students, parents, staff, etc.).

6. Do a diaper drive for pregnancy resource centers.

7. Educate your club on what abortion is. Use the animated Live-Action educational videos. High school kids need to know and understand what actually happens in an abortion, especially the horrific live-dismemberment abortion technique that ends 9 lives in Kansas every week! Too many post-abortive young women say, "If I had only known... but no one told me."

8. Write letters to elderly in nursing homes. Send cards on holidays. Do personal visits when able.

9. Find out who are the elderly in the community of your high school and rake their leaves in the fall.

10. Attend the first Saturday pro-life Mass at Nativity followed by praying the rosary outside of Planned Parenthood (see the www.archkck.org/prolife calendar for details).

11. Sign up your club to pray at the 40 Days for Life vigil in both the spring and fall events.

12. Have your club participate in the Life Chain on Respect Life Sunday.

13. Join the Kansas Rosary Crusade for the passage of the Value Them Both Kansas Constitutional Amendment and promote praying the rosary every Thursday in your school until the amendment is passed (www.kansasrosarycrusade.org).

14. Every month, put up posters/messaging in your school on different pro-life topics. Find handouts and educational pieces at www.respectlife.org/celebrate (USCCB website). Ask your school admin to include a prayer petition each week for that specific issue (abortion, euthanasia, suicide, adoption, death penalty...)

15. Design a new pro-life t-shirt every year and sell as a fundraiser.

16. Adopt a pro-life organization every year to pray for and do projects for (Pregnancy Centers, Nativity House maternity home, nursing homes, foster care agencies, etc.)

17. Attend the Kansas March for Life in January.

18. Attend the March for Life March in DC if possible.

19. Participate in a pro-life conference or host a pro-life conference for your school.

20. Hold an all-school Mass or prayer service during the months of October (Respect Life Month) and January (for the Legal Protection of the Unborn).

21. Share and post the Archdiocesan Urgent Life Resource List around your school.

22. Become educated on Abortion Pill Reversal.

23. Study the Archdiocesan Pro-Life Website (www.archkck.org/prolife), the Gabriel Project Website (www.gabrielprojectkc.org), the Project Rachel website (www.projectrachelkc.com), and the ArchKCK Foster Care Ministry Website (www.archkck.org/foster) to become familiar with these pro-life ministries. Also study the Catholic Guide for End of Life (www.archkck.org/prolife-end-of-life-care).

24. Do a study of Pope Saint John Paul II's Evangelium vitae (Gospel of Life).

25. Put a plan together on how your club can assist with the Walking With Moms in Need: A Year of Service Initiative. (www.walkingwithmoms.com).
