Pilgrims of Hope

This Jubilee Holy Year 2025 marks the 2,025th anniversary of the Incarnation of our Lord, an "event of great spiritual, ecclesial, and social significance in the life of the Church." The concept of "jubilee" has its origins in the Book of Leviticus (chapter 25) as a special year of reconciliation and reunion. Pope Francis has designated this a "Holy Year marked by the hope that does not fade, our hope in God." We are called to consider our journey of faith as pilgrims who live joyfully that "through our witness, may hope spread to all those who anxiously seek it."

Plenerary Indulgences

The Vatican has decreed an opportunity for Catholics to receive a plenary indulgence during the 2025 Jubilee Holy Year. A plenary indulgence is "a priceless gift of divine mercy" that "allows us to discover how limitless God's mercy is." We are called to be the hands and feet of Jesus for others. Pope Francis has approved plenary indulgence opportunities for works of mercy and penance. Travel to Archdiocesan Sacred Jubilee Sites

Archbishop Naumann has declared that, along with the Cathedral of St. Peter, all churches with the Archdiocese under the patronage of the Sacred Heart of Jesus be designated as Sacred Jubilee Sites.
