LIFE CHAIN is Sunday, October 5th, from 1:30 - 2:30 pm (Johnson County). Life Chain is an annual, nationwide, peaceful, prayerful hour of silence on public sidewalks supporting the dignity of and right to life. Over 100 churches locally, nearly 1,000 churches statewide, and many thousands of churches nationwide are participating at the same time.

REMINDERS/RULES:

ATTITUDE: This is a peaceful event. Talking is discouraged and prayer is requested while silently holding pro-life messages. Many passersby give the thumbs up and some even stop and join, but some indicate their disagreement and not always in a nice way. Simply ignore and pray for them, that their hearts will be awakened to the awful reality of abortion as it affects unborn babies and their mothers!

MESSAGE: We provide any number needed of many different pre-made signs procured from the national Life Chain organization so that the messages are the same coast to coast. They can be picked up at the KFL Office. Please CALL FIRST 913.642.5433 or 913.406.4446 Mon - Fri 10-2. Return the signs anytime the following month.

SAFETY: Stand on the sidewalk only! Keep children away from the streets. Absolutely no sitting on curbs, and all small children must be held or in strollers.
