

# You and your family deserve to be safe and loved in your home.

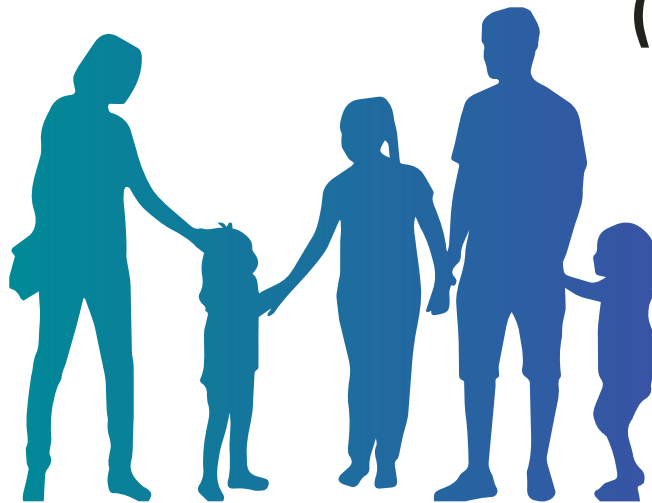
Sometimes bad things happen in good families. Yelling, hitting,
