# MISSIONARY ENCOUNTER

Our team went to Hayden High School in Topeka Kansas where we were giving all day talks on human dignity to every theology class. I was sitting in the campus ministry room waiting to give a talk when the school Chaplain came up to my teammates and I to speak with us. He explained to us that he was very thankful for us being at their school to speak and that he already noticed fruits of our work coming about despite us only giving two talks so far that day. He then explained how after one of the talks, a male student came to him and expressed that because of our presentation in particular, he wanted to get rid of an addiction in his life and live differently. The priest then explained how he told the boy that the school would have confessions tomorrow and that the boy said he'd be there. He really tried to affirm us in the goodness of our presence there. Our human dignity talk covers a variety of topics such as bullying, abortion, and pornography; and it's not everyday that we get to hear an immediate fruit of how our talks affect people, but it was such a gift to hear this from Fr. Maddock about the student whose heart was stirred that day.


