

A Promising Poll: Americans Continue to Back Abortion Limits

A brand-new poll — the Marist Poll — just came out with some heartening news. This [poll](#), commissioned by the Knights of Columbus and performed by a trusted source for national surveys,* reported:

- 64% of Americans support placing legal limits on abortion;
- 84% support pregnancy resource centers, these centers that outnumber abortion facilities more than four to one and provide women life-affirming alternatives to abortion;
- 63% of Americans believe healthcare professionals should not be forced to commit abortions against their religiously held beliefs; and
- 88% of Americans believe that laws can protect both mother and child.

Based on this data, we can confidently say that when the other side claims Americans want abortion on demand through all nine months of pregnancy for any reason, that's absurd. **Most Americans want significant restrictions on abortion.**

EMBRACE GRACE – Parish-based Support Group for Single, Pregnant Women




Kansans for Life Banquet 2026


